It is very important to have a teacher or teachers who have their endorsement in gifted education on the committee.

Job Description:

- Oversee the identification and services of high potential talent pool students (K-3) and formally identified gifted students (4-12) in their buildings.
- Ensure that a variety of views are heard during the selection and placement process.
- Assess current selection/identification practices and services provided.
- Develop an action plan to improve any areas that are not meeting Kentucky's Regulations in Gifted and Talented Education.
- Monitor the school improvement plan for gifted/talented education.
- Plan professional learning in how to select, identify, and serve students in the 5 areas (general intellectual ability, specific academic aptitude, creativity, leadership, the visual and performing arts)
- Help provide communication and support in the schools and community.
