The Primary Talent Pool is designed to provide challenging learning opportunities for high-potential students in grades K through 3. The Gifted Regulation provides guidelines for an effective Primary Talent Pool.

A Primary Talent Pool that is designed to promote growth in a diverse group of students

should include the following elements:
Does the school have an active Primary Talent Pool?
Does the demographic makeup of the PTP mirror that of the school?
Is the number of students in the PTP at or near 25% of the primary students?
Are multiple informal measures used to select students?
Is a universal screener used to find high-potential students?
Does the PTP curriculum feature open-ended activities that require creative and Critical thinking?
Are services matched to needs, interests, and abilities?
Are there multiple service delivery options?
